Parade Entry Rules

- Safety first – All entry equipment must be in good working order and participants must conduct themselves in a safe manner.
- Parade entries that include animals must clean up immediately after waste production occurs.
- Do not delay the parade flow. Maintain your speed and distance between your group and the entry in front of you. If you stop to perform for the crowd, you must limit the stop to 20 seconds and you must catch up with the entry in front of you before stopping again. Large gaps in the parade are detrimental to the enjoyment of viewing the parade. Entries causing large gaps in the parade will not be invited back.
- Vehicles and entries must be decorated. People remember and speak positively about those entries that are well decorated.
- Participants must follow directions provided by police and parade marshals along the parade route.
- Local and neighboring elected officials are invited to participate in the parade; however, political lobbying and electioneering groups are not.
- Have fun.

All entries received with a signed declaration will be accepted for entry in the parade (we reserve the right to make exceptions) so entrants do not need to confirm entry. We will notify those entries that are not accepted for previous infractions of the parade rules.
